

Albers Trio

From an early age the Albers sisters have captivated audiences with musical styles as diverse as their distinctive personalities and features. Beginning with their childhood performances on the Pearl Street Mall in Boulder, CO the sisters have gone on to perform at such venues as Alice Tully Hall at Lincoln Center, National Theatre in Taipei, Severance Hall, Wigmore Hall in London, and Weill Recital Hall and Zankel Hall at Carnegie. Their performances have also been seen and heard onLive from Lincoln Center, Kennedy Center Honors, Japan's NHK, Washington D.C.'s Voice of America and Bavarian Radio. In recent seasons the Albers Trio has appeared in such series as the Harvard Musical Association, Mondavi Center Performing Arts, Peggy Rockefeller Concerts, San Francisco Performances and the Santa Fe Concert Association.

The Albers Trio sees outreach as an integral part of its musical life, and in conjunction with performances, enjoys presenting educational programs in schools across the country. Recognizing the importance of contemporary music, the Trio also strives to work with one living composer each year, bringing today's music to today's audiences.
